UNIQUE DESIGN TRAITS

This bold royal blue sapphire weighing over 11 carats is the focal point of this detailed ring design; accompanied by an AGL report stating its origin is Madagascar.

Its triple claw-like prongs provide protection and importance, but they are still delicate due to their exquisite craftsmanship, which doesn't detract from the center stone.

The shank has a distinct harlequin-like pattern, with expertly matched tapering sapphires running its length; diamonds are set between the stones and the overall design is simultaneously classic and modern.

GEMSTONE DETAILS

Blue Sapphire

Beloved for centuries as the ultimate blue gemstone, sapphire is part of the Corundum mineral family and is an ideal choice for everyday wear. With a hardness of 9 on the Mohs scale, sapphire of any color is one of the hardest gemstones behind a diamond. Sapphire is found in many parts of the world, but the most prized sapphires are from Myanmar (Burma), Kashmir and Sri Lanka (Ceylon). The purer the blue of the sapphire, the greater the value of the gemstone, with the trade term 'Royal Blue' given to the most valuable shade. Due to their crystal growth, larger sapphires are most often found in fancy brilliant cuts, like oval or cushion, large rounds and emerald cuts are markedly rarer to encounter. Sapphire is the birthstone for September and the gem of the 5th and 45th anniversaries.


